- The CV of the submitter and/or the profile of a group of individuals practicing civil engineering in Canada, or Canadian engineering firm, or a Canadian research organization
- This Project Entry Form
- The Project file: Only one copy is required. It should include the following:
 - **Project Summary** – The title of the Innovation and a summary of the project (60 Words Max)
 - **Project Highlights** - 2 Pages Maximum.
 - a) A clear description of the innovation
 - b) A comparison with the existing/conventional practice
 - c) The anticipated advantages to be obtained by the innovation
 - d) The circumstances about which the innovation was conceived
 - e) Other information you consider pertinent for consideration
 - **Full Project Description.** Gives full details, drawings etc. on the project. Letters of satisfaction from clients are welcome. Number of pages is not limited, but 10 pages is the recommended maximum.
 - **Photographs** A maximum of 5 photographs of the innovation will be accepted. Photographs will not be returned. Applicants must obtain the rights from their photographer to reprint the photographs without limitations.
